## Requirements

18 semester hours of art, including six hours of advanced work (3000 or 4000 level), are required for the bachelor's degree minor.

The Department of Visual Arts also requires that at least half of the hours for a minor be taken at TWU, which means that no more than nine hours can be transferred in. All upper-level classes must be taken at TWU.
