The program provides advanced instruction in health sciences librarianship. Students gain the knowledge and skills required to effectively apply and support evidence-based practice in healthcare settings. Graduates work in a variety of health information settings, such as libraries, medical associations, hospitals, health centers, and state and federal agencies. The MLS with Certificate in Health Sciences Librarianship program is available entirely online.
