The Post-Master's Certificate in School Librarianship program provides an opportunity for students who already hold a master's degree in library science or another discipline to pursue School Librarian Certification (SLC) in Texas. The program prepares professionals for careers as school librarians in elementary schools, middle schools, and high schools (EC-12) in the state of Texas. The Post-Master's Certificate in School Librarianship program is available entirely online.

The School Librarian Certification (SLC) program offered by Texas Woman's University meets all requirements of the State Board for Educator Certification for public schools in Texas and is accredited by the Texas Education Agency.

Marketable Skills
