- Wi-Fi (<https://servicecenter.twu.edu/TDClient/Requests/ServiceDet/?ID=12101>) for connectivity of personal devices as well as access to computers through general use computer labs (<https://servicecenter.twu.edu/TDClient/KB/?CategoryID=5951>), classroom teaching computer labs, and department labs that directly support academic programs;
- Each student is eligible for certain technology discounts (<https://servicecenter.twu.edu/TDClient/Requests/ServiceCatalog/?CategoryID=3586>) through our partnership with E-Academy OnTheHub (<http://twu.onthehub.com/>).
- TWU technology is strategically located in common areas such as the Denton campus Student Union, student lounges, the Blagg-Huey Library, and residence halls;
- Free black and white two-sided printing is available to all students in all computer labs; color printing (<https://servicecenter.twu.edu/TDClient/KB/ArticleDet/?ID=51481>) is available in some computer labs at a cost of \$0.40 per page; additionally, students may print from their device (<https://servicecenter.twu.edu/TDClient/KB/ArticleDet/?ID=60619>) and pick up at a computer lab printer;
