At the time of enrollment in nursing courses, the registered nurse must provide proof of:

- Current unencumbered licensure as a registered nurse in the United
  States.
- 2. Current Basic Life Support (BLS) certification from the American Heart Association.
- 3. Current required immunizations as specified by TWU Student Health Services
- Negative drug testing and criminal background screening by a company designated by the College of Nursing.
- 5. Proof of personal health insurance (required by clinical facilities).

- 6. Completion of HIPAA training.
- 7. Social Security Number.
- 8. Photo Identification.
