Marketable Skills

Defined by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's 60x30 Strategic Plan (<https://reportcenter.highered.texas.gov/agency-publication/miscellaneous/theccb-60x30-strategic-plan/>) as, "Those skills valued by employers that can be applied in a variety of work settings, including interpersonal, cognitive, and applied skills areas. These skills can be either primary or complementary to a major and are acquired by students through education, including curricular, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities."

- a. Function in multidisciplinary teams
- b. Apply ethical principles to provide leadership in promoting advocacy, collaboration, and social justice within the health care system and to act in a manner reflective of professional values and value-based behavior
- c. Use written, verbal, non-verbal, and emerging technology to communicate effectively and deliver quality patient care in a variety of health care settings
- d. Apply basic organizational and systems leadership for quality health care and patient safety.
- e. Identify, evaluate and apply scientific evidence, clinical judgment, interprofessional perspective, and patient preference to the practice of nursing
- f. Knowledge of healthcare policies, both financial and regulatory, and how they impact nursing practice and the health care system
- g. Clinical reasoning within the context of patient-centered care across the lifespan, to diverse patients, that reflects ethical values
